

We are in the final stages in planning for the 2020-2021 School Year. Our first priority remains the health and well-being of our students and staff members. As of now, and assuming conditions remain the same with COVID-19:

- North Judson-San Pierre will NOT alter our 2020-2021 School Calendar. We will start as planned (August 12).
- North Judson-San Pierre will NOT have a “staggered” or “alternate-day” schedule. We will conduct our traditional scheduled days as normal with students coming everyday.
- Students will be able to eat lunch with peers, have recess, and engage in traditional social school settings. Social distancing will be practiced. How social distancing will be practiced in these settings will be explained in our plan.
- **If you are already registered and plan to send your student(s) back to school under “normal” school procedures, you do NOT need to do anything, as registration has already taken place.**
- **North Judson-San Pierre will offer an option for families to learn from home using digital devices.**
