Re: Snow make-up days

We have the following days to make up due to cancellations because of inclement weather: January 23, 25, 29, and 31. (November 15 cancellation was made up on February 18 as an eLearning day, January 28, 30 and February 12 were eLearning days and don't need to be made up)

Moving forward, in the event of a school closure, we will use eLearning days for school closures due to weather. Please see below the snow-make up day times.

- Monday, February 18, 2019— eLearning day from November 15 cancellation
- Saturday, March 2, 2019—eLearning day
- Saturday, April 13, 2019—eLearning day
- Friday, April 19, 2019—eLearning day
- Friday, May 24—snow make up day at school

The decision to incorporate eLearning for snow make-up days was made due to the brutal winter weather that forced us multiple days of closure. While Saturdays present a different “feel” than a typical weekday, we will use similar guidelines and also add some features that allow flexibility for students, families, and teachers.

- For the two (2) Saturday eLearning days, students will receive Saturday eLearning work by the end of the day Friday before or earlier if possible. Students will have the entire weekend and until Wednesday before assignments will be considered late. This will provide students time in case they have any Saturday activities that limit work time.
- Teachers will be available by Google chat or email over the course of the weekend. Teachers will provide a more detailed explanation of communication methods in their lesson.

For students with limited or no access to the Internet, arrangements can be made with teacher for alternative format OR students may use a computer at the Elementary School computer lab from 9:00 AM-12:00 Noon.

I know that we are never able to replace a day with students and teachers, but I also believe that it is important that the make-up day is as productive as it can be. Planned eLearning days can be more productive than days at the end of May. Also, participating in digital learning is important for our students.
