## **Approval of Lunch Price Proposals**

Mrs. Brewer made a motion to approve Lunch Price Proposals as presented. Mr. Menis seconded the motion; motion carried 5-0

## NJ-SP Due Diligence in Fiscal Responsibility

Dr. Zupin discussed the next level teacher compensation commission report, discussing Fiscal recommendations for the schools and incoming CARES/ESSERS grants allowing an opportunity to make long-range plans and decisions regarding budgeting, staffing, and facilities. NJ-SP will begin regular reviews and assessments of contracted services. Employee Health, School Liability Insurance, Bank of Depository, and Financial Advisor were discussed. Mr. Tunis discussed other initiatives including NJ-SP taking over all lawn services in-house as well as NJ-SP taking on snow removal services, train/certify Maintenance department in specialized areas (when appropriate to do so) HVAC, electrical, fertilizer, and pesticides, and utilize centralized procurement sources; NIESC, CIESC, and Sourcewell.

#### **ESSERS Summary**

Dr. Zupin summarized the continuation of Student Support Services, including a Social Worker, Speech Language Pathologist Assistant, and an additional School Nurse. The Continuation of Instructional Intervention, including Jr-Sr High Math, Elementary Reading, and Elementary Math. Air quality measures including filters and AC units. Stipends for staff for the 2020-2021 School year and Budget Appropriations for additional instructional staff if necessary.

#### **Project Update**

Dr. Zupin gave an update on the Elementary demolition and new gym, the Bus Garage is just waiting on doors and the High School Gym floor will get a final coat when all is finished, and Daktronics will provide training to staff for the scoreboards.

#### **MySchool Bucks Fee**

Mr. Tunis explained the increase of the MySchool Bucks program fee for all cafeteria credit/debit card payments will be increasing from \$1.95 to \$2.75 effective July 29, 2021, stating "the fee has been \$1.95 for many years and increased due to steadily rising operating costs over the last few years.

#### **Budget Preparation**

Mr. Tunis notified the important dates regarding Budget Preparation. There will be a Budget Work Session and Special Board Meeting on August 2, 2021 (time to be determined), Starke County Council will be August 16, 2021, at 5:30 PM CST, NJ-SP Regular Board Meeting will be August 17, 2021, at 5:30 PM CST, and Starke County Council will meet September 20, 2021, at 5:30 PM CST.
