Resetting Your iPad

Sometimes things get stuck on your iPad. Certain apps won't work correctly. Your camera appears, but the shutter won't work. You hear the click of the camera taking pictures, but there are no photos. You see the volume control in your screen when you didn't do anything with the volume. There is a simple fix to these problem. Just re-set your iPad.

Updating apps regularly and quitting apps will minimize this problem.

Reset Instructions

Follow the instructions in the illustration below to reset your iPad.

You will not see the slide button that you use to turn off your iPad .

After you see the Apple logo and let go, your iPad will reboot which will take a minute or so. When the home screen appears, your iPad is ready for use. If the problem still exists after resetting, contact the Help Desk.



1. Hold down sleep/wake button and home button simultaneously
2. Let go when you see the Apple logo

New Look, New Features – iOS 7

When you update the operating system of your iPad, you will notice a new look. Along with that new look are some new features. Besides the **bright new color palette and redesigned app look**, one of the most exciting features is the multitasking feature.

When you click the Home Button twice, all your open apps will appear on the screen instead of on a multitasking bar at the bottom. They will be large and you can **touch to reactivate or swipe upward to quit**. No more jiggling Xs!

Another modified feature is the Camera app. You can **swipe between modes – video, still, and square**. It is very quick and easy to use.

The Photos app has also been revamped. Your **photos are automatically organized by date and place**. No more LONG camera roll!
