Organizing Your Apps

To re-arrange the **apps** on your iPad, just touch one of the **apps** on your home screen until they all start to wiggle. You can now move your **apps** to preferred positions on the home page or to the dock. Touch the home button to stop the wiggling.

If you move one or more **apps** on top of another, you can create a folder of similar **apps** and give the folder a new name. To move **apps** in and out of folders, just touch any **app** until the **apps** wiggle and **move** them to another position.

Caring for Your iPad

It's important to maintain your **iPad** properly so that you'll have a minimum of problems in the future.

KEEP THE SCREEN CLEAN!

Although oil-resistant, the screen of your **iPad** should be cleaned periodically.

Use a dry, soft cloth such as the one you would use to clean your

eyeglasses or your HD TV.

If the screen is really dirty you can use a slightly moistened soft, lint-free cloth. Be sure your **iPad** is not plugged in.

NEVER USE PRE-MOISTENED LENS CLEANERS SINCE THEY USUALLY CONTAIN ALCOHOL.

TURN OFF YOUR iPad!

Give your **iPad** a break once-in-a-while and turn it completely off for the night or weekend.

GREAT FREE APPS FOR YOUR IPAD

Now that you've become acquainted with your iPad, you might want to take a look at some of the free apps available in the App Store.

Wikipanion for iPad

Forget accessing Wikipedia through Safari. Download *Wikipanion*, an app designed for easy, search, navigation and display of *Wikipedia* entries. Streamline your browsing with history grouped by visit date, and bookmarking that not only bookmarks individual entries, but individual sections within an entry.

Find My iPhone

Find My iPhone might perhaps be better named 'Find my Apple stuff', because it's not just for figuring out where a missing iPhone is—it can

also track iPads, iPods and Macs. The app is simple, elegant and, generally speaking, provides an accurate location for devices. It also enables you to remote-lock or wipe a device.

BBC News

Although the *BBC News* website works nicely on the iPad, *BBC News* app is still worth downloading. Rather than trying to provide all of the news, it instead concentrates on the latest stories, with inline video. Categories can be rearranged, stories can be shared and the app's layout adjusts to portrait and landscape orientations.
