

Starke County Community Scholarship

Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship

This scholarship provides for one scholarship for full tuition, required fees, and a special allocation of up to \$900.00 per year for required books and equipment for four years of undergraduate study on a full-time basis, leading to a bachelor's degree at any Indiana public or private university.

To be eligible:

- 1) Student must be a Starke county high school senior graduating by the end of June 2020 with a diploma.
- 2) Student must be accepted for a full-time bachelor's course of study at an accredited public or private college or university in Indiana. Homebound students are not eligible to apply.
- 3) Student must be a Starke county resident.

To Apply:

- 1) Go to the Community's website at: www.cfopc.org and click on "Scholarships".
- 2) Click on the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship app link. You will then be redirected to Smarterselect.com and asked to create a username/password. Do Not Give Out This Information!
- 3) You are ready to begin filling out the application. You can save your information and return later at any time to complete and submit your application before the deadline.
- 4) Application must be submitted by **Friday, September 13th, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. EST.** Late applications will not be accepted.
- 5) Certification/Signature page needs to be signed and turned in to the Community Foundation of Pulaski County or guidance office before the deadline. Parent signature is also required if student is under 18.
- 6) Have the guidance office email your transcript directly to CF before the deadline. Give at least one week notice for this.
