Delivery of Learning

Delivery of Continuous Learning Opportunities

- NJ-SP will offer our traditional, in-person programming to meet the needs of all students.
- NJ-SP will administer formative assessments to identify skill gaps.
- NJ-SP will offer additional instructional support and remediation for students who show skill gaps.
- NJ-SP will conduct regular meetings throughout the year with teachers to identify where students are academically.
- NJ-SP will offer tutoring sessions after school for students who need extra time and support in academics.
- NJ-SP teachers will prepare for potential future eLearning/remote learning.
- Teachers of our special student populations will provide direct assistance with their students person-to-person as specified in their IEP, 504 plans, or ILP.

Achievement and Attendance

Avenues for students to earn high school credits

- The NJ-SP Continuous Learning Plan provides avenues for our students to recover high school credit:
 - by utilizing the Apex Software and by completing courses via Google Classroom and/or;
 - re-taking courses that were not passed in previous grading period(s)

Attendance Policy for Continuous Learning

- Student attendance for students participating in learning at school will be based on physical attendance in each class.

Long-term goals to address skill gaps for the 2021-2022 School Year

- NJ-SP has hired two (2) Interventionist—one in each building—to service students demonstrating deficiency in the area of Mathematics and/or English Language Arts.
- NJ-SP has hired two tutors to assist students demonstrating deficiency in Literacy and/or English Language Arts

Staff Development

Professional Development Plan for Continuous Learning

- NJ-SP Teachers continue to participate in professional development regarding quality digital delivery of instruction.

- NJ-SP Teachers will have future opportunities to refresh, follow-up, and build on the digital delivery of instruction skills during the 2021-2022 School Year.
- Teachers have collaboration time built in to the school year to work collectively on analyzing and interpreting data in order to plan quality instruction.

COVID-19 Measures

COVID positive person:

- Stay home and isolate from other people for at least 5 full days (day 0 is the first day of symptoms or the date of the day of the positive viral test for asymptomatic persons)
- People who are in isolation may return to school on day 6 as long as they are fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications and symptoms have improved
- They should wear a mask when around others at home, in public and at school for an additional 5 days (days 6-10)

Contact tracing and quarantining of close contacts, including family members, will not be performed.
