

This is just a reminder that our eLearning schedule will change on Monday, April 13 to 3 days per week. (See schedule below). As previously stated, this change is in order to be compliant with the Department of Education (DOE) in conducting 160 instructional learning days for the 2019-2020 school year. Teachers are being purposeful in their lessons and will make assignments more project and application based. This means there will not always be 3 days' worth of assignments, as some eLearning days will be "work" days.

Important Points:

- North Judson-San Pierre students will finish out the school year prior to Memorial Day using eLearning days. If you do not have access to the Internet, please contact your child's teachers to make arrangements for alternative assignments.
- **ALL** NJ-SP students are expected and required to complete eLearning assignments in order to earn credits and advance in their courses for next year.
- Mr. Polite and Ms. McCarthy will begin assessing each Senior student individually to check eligibility status for graduation in the upcoming weeks. More information will come regarding Seniors, as the DOE continues to provide guidance regarding graduation.
- Attendance for students is based on submitted/completed assignments—it is crucial for **ALL** NJ-SP students to complete the eLearning lessons assigned by their teachers.
- We are aware that students have personal belongings in their lockers and/or desks. Once NJ-SP officials gain permission from the DOE and State/local Health officials, a plan will be shared on how students can come and claim their belongings. We anticipate this will not happen until at least May 4.
- The Prom scheduled for May 2 has been postponed. Mr. Polite and Mrs. Dudka are discussing options and are hopeful in having a prom.
- A traditional commencement (graduation) ceremony on May 31st does not look plausible. Mr. Polite is beginning conversations with teachers and Senior students on possible options. A celebration and ceremony for our Senior students and their academic achievements will occur in some format.
- Lunches will continue to be provided and served by our cafeteria workers and bus drivers. The format and process may change in order to be more

efficient. Please stay tuned to our social media pages and WKVI for possible changes to our lunch service.
